ORGANIZATION

POSITION SUMMARY

The Camp and Animal Care Assistant is an integral part of our animal care and summer camp team.Camp Animal Care Assistants are responsible for maintaining the safety and care of our animals including horses, goats, sheep, chickens, ducks, and cats. This position works independently with minimal supervision while also being a part of a dynamic team that regularly interacts with students and teachers. Applicants must be able to take direction, possess critical thinking skills, and exhibit good communication. Animal Care Assistants report to the Sienna Ranch Animal Care Manager, Education Manager and Executive Director.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Essential Job Functions include but are not limited to the following:

- Completing basic animal husbandry skills such as maintaining a clean animal pen, ensuring animals have access to fresh clean water, and are safely secured within their pens. Additional animal husbandry tasks included grooming, hoof picking, hoof/nail trimming, among others.
- Cleaning out the animal accommodations daily and changing bedding as set forth by the Animal Care Manager.
- Assisting with moving animals around the site, including weekend horse turnout.
- Monitors all animals for signs of illness, distress or unusual behavior; makes clear notations and reports problems regarding health and behavior of animals to the Animal Care Manager and Animal Care team.
- Ensuring that the animal enclosures are maintained to the standards set forth by the Animal Care Manager.
- Handling animals firmly but gently using interaction methods and best practices outlined by the Animal Care Manager.
- Following health and safety procedures within the workplace.
- Learning garden maintenance (watering on weekends, assisting with plantings and weeding).
- Assisting with student drop off and pick up (on weekdays only).
- Assisting with minor facilities and landscaping tasks.
- Often lift and carry materials weighing up to 50 lbs.
- Animal Feeding shifts (all feeding shifts are logged as 1 hour at minimum rate).
- Supporting Horse Camp riding program/instructors as horse handler during riding lessons.
- Support Camp classes by managing lunch coverage for camp classes and supporting instructors with camp tasks throughout the day including early pick ups, supply prep, and clean up

REQUIREMENTS

- A sincere passion for connecting to animals, children, nature, and working in all weather
- Experience/familiarity working with animals and particularly livestock (horses, goats, sheep, ducks, chickens, cats). Other experience can include 4H, animal apprenticeships, vet clinics, animal shelters, or pet daycares
- Committed to being a solution-oriented, self-motivated community member in a cooperative, team-oriented atmosphere
- Be a model of kindness, flexibility and professionalism
- Able to check and respond to email communications within 24 business hours
- Current First Aid and CPR for Adult and Child certifications, and clear TB test results (or ability to acquire before first day or work), and ability to pass FBI/DOJ background check for working with children
- Current COVID vaccination certification
- Certificate of completion for California Child Abuse Mandated Reporter Training
- Minimum age requirement: 16 years old. Applicants currently in school must provide a valid work permit.
